**Angus Tallini – Clinical Director**

## **Increased demand**

15% increase in patient contacts in past 5 years

## **Greater complexity**

Number with long term conditions risen from 1.9 million in 2009 to 2.9 million in 2018

## **People living longer**

By 2029 the number of people aged 75+ set to be 7.8m. It is currently 5.8m.

## **Seven day service**

Access to GP appointments, 7 days a week



## **Ageing workforce**

The workforce is ageing – 23% of GPs and 38% of PNs in BW are aged 55 or over

## **GP working hours**

69% of GPs are working part time or flexible hours

## **Investment**

Cash for Primary Care has lagged behind other NHS sectors. But £4.5bn announced in NHS Long Term Plan

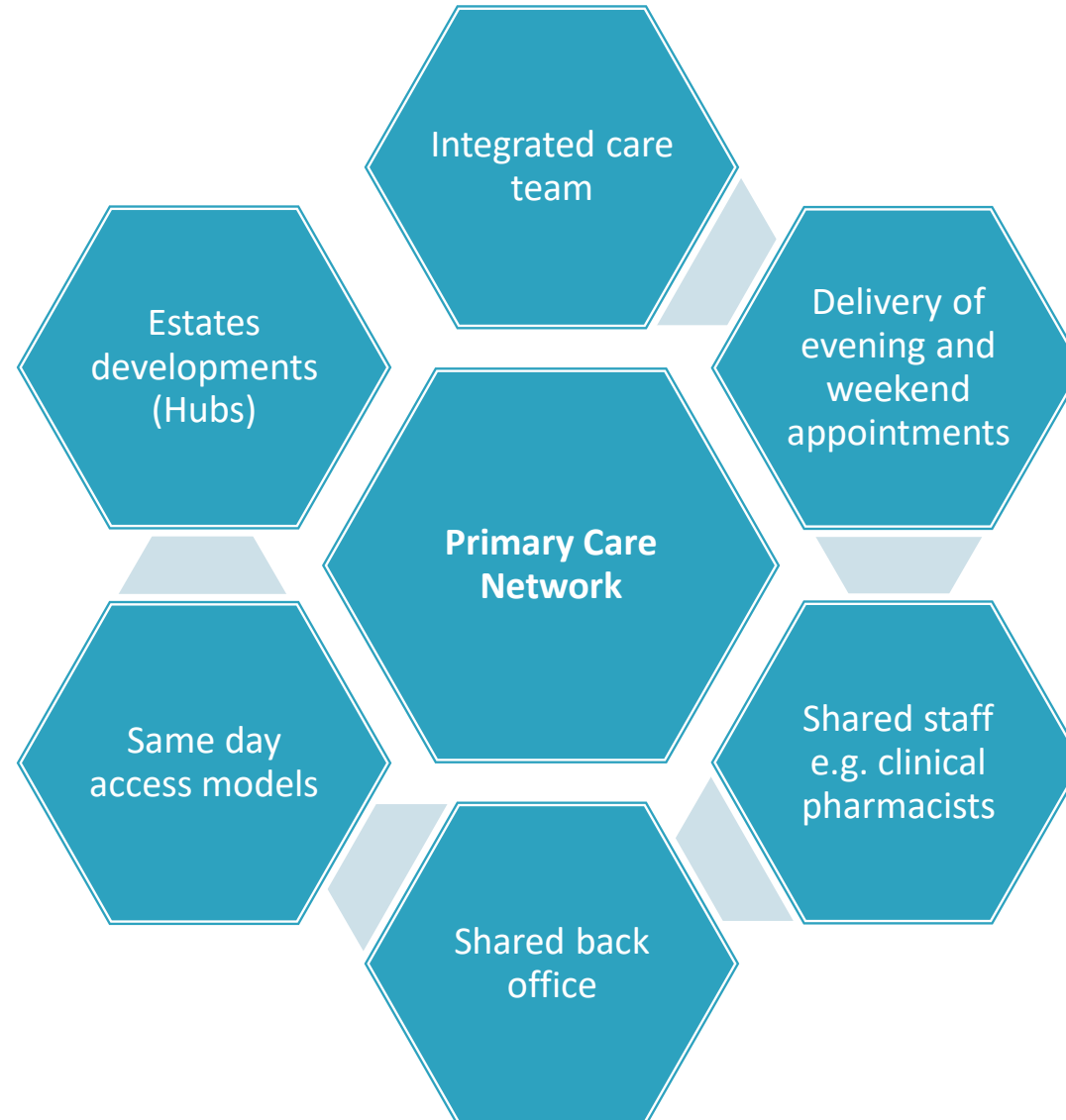
